

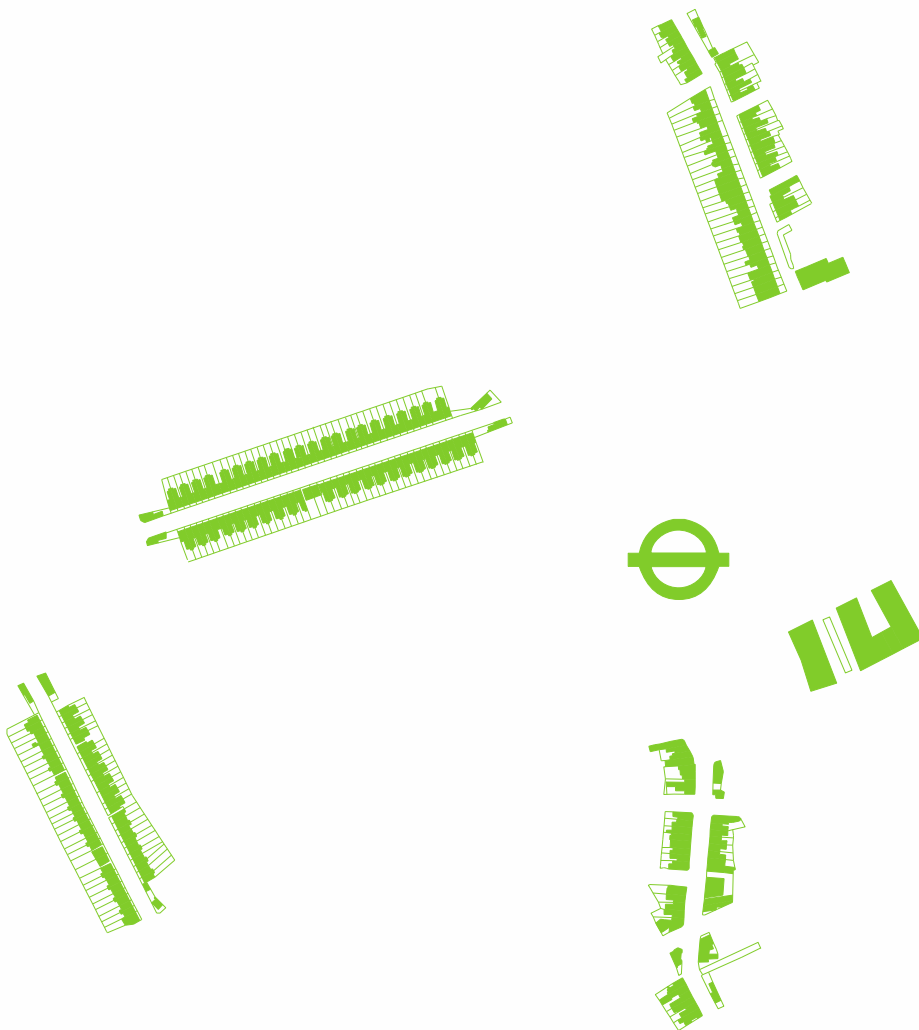

# What is the Neighbourhood Greening Project?

## What is the project?

The Neighbourhood Greening Project is a 3 year project looking to support people to green their streets, front gardens and public spaces.

The 5 seedling streets component is the first phase with future phases to be delivered on other streets and spaces.

The aim of this first phase is to help bring people together to green 'public facing' areas of their homes. This includes front gardens and balconies facing on to streets.

## Who is delivering the project?

St James Street Big Local is delivering the project with support from what if: projects Ltd. Lancaster's Garden Centre on Wood Street is providing the plants.

## What area does the project cover?

This first phase of the project is focused on the 5 'seedling streets' within the St James Street Big Local Area. The streets are spread out across the Big Local area and comprise:

- Brunner Road
- Buxton Road
- Hazelwood Road
- Morland Road
- Station Road

Although we're focusing on these streets, if you live on a different street please do consider if you want to apply!

## Where does the funding come from?

The funding is from the St James Street Big Local and Mayor of London's Greener City Fund.

## When is the project being carried out?

The first phase of the project has been in development during 2020. From late March to 30 April 2020 we're taking orders for street greening. After this first phase future projects will be delivered.

## How does it relate to Waltham Forest Council greening projects?

We work closely with Council officers to ensure our projects complement each other and help connect the Council with local groups interesting in shaping and maintaining Council greening projects.

# HOW IT WORKS



## ST. JAMES STREET BIG LOCAL

1. Fill out your menu selections and return to St. James Big Local at [stjamesbiglocal@gmail.com](mailto:stjamesbiglocal@gmail.com) by 30 April 2021.

The project is focused on the 5 'seedling streets' of Brunner Road, Buxton Road, Hazelwood Road, Morland Road and Station Road.

These have been selected based on existing street greening, location of civic facilities, use of streets for walking and cycling routes and community interest.

Residents from other streets may also place orders.

2. Big Local will validate and confirm your selection and order.

Orders will be confirmed having consideration to when they were placed and ensuring a geographic distribution across the 5 streets and the area.

3. Big Local will send the orders to Lancaster's garden centre at weekly intervals and confirm orders with residents.

Substitutions may be needed depending on availability; we'll try to ensure any substitutes are of similar species and size to those on the menu.

4. Once the order has been placed, Lancaster's garden centre will liaise with residents to arrange a convenient delivery date. Deliveries will take about 3 weeks. Residents will need to be in for the deliveries.

It's then over to residents to get planting and share photos of their greening with St James Street Big Local via email or social media!

# THE MENU

# Front Gardens Menu

All plants and seeds will be supplied with the required amount of soil and compost. If needed, containers will also be supplied.

## 1. STARTER HEDGES

Hedging plants need to be planted along the wall facing the street within your garden. You will need to plant hedging plants in the ground as they are not suitable for containers.

### How wide is your front garden in metres or feet?

We need to know how wide your front garden is to tell us how many hedging plants are needed. Exclude the width of your path

A mix of plants from the below list will be provided. This list reflects local plants seen around Walthamstow and Walthamstow Marshes. They'll be about 1 metre tall.

- Guelder Rose, *Viburnum opulus 'Roseum'*
- Hazel, *Corylus Avellana Red Majestic*
- Holly, *Ilex aquifolium*
- Field Maple, *Acer Campestre*
- Red Cascade Spindle, *Euonymus europaeus*

## 2. FRUIT TREES

Fruit trees are available if you're not having hedging and your front garden is large enough. They'll be between 1 to 1.5 metres tall and will be self-fertile pollinating varieties.

You can select up to 2 trees and they can be planted in the ground or in a container.

A vertical planting structure of five rows measuring 60cm wide by 1m tall. Made of 100% recycled plastic, each row is 12cm deep and holds 3-6 plants.
